ORDINANCE NO. 2021-13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 240, ARTICLE II, OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF CLEMENTON ENTITLED, "SOLID WASTE"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF CLEMENTON, COUNTY OF CAMDEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 240, Section 6, of the Code of the Borough of Clementon is hereby amended and supplemented by the addition of a new definition inserted alphabetically as follows:

§ 240-6. Definitions.

BRUSH (TREE AND SHRUB DEBRIS) - Includes shrubs and small trees, or cut branches or twigs; brushwood.

SECTION 2. Chapter 240, Section 8, of the Code of the Borough of Clementon is hereby amended and supplemented by the addition of a new section I, as follows:

- I. Brush shall be placed curbside for collection on a bi-weekly schedule established by the Department of Public Works.
 - (1) Only brush up to six (6) inches in diameter and no longer than eight (8) feet in length will be collected.
 - (2) All full length limbs (up to 8 feet in length) shall be placed curbside with all cut ends facing the same direction.
 - (3) Brush can be tied in smaller bundles with twine, rope, or other similar materials not to exceed 50 lbs.
 - (4) No more than eight (8) cubic yards of brush (approximately 3 feet high, 6 feet in width, and 12 feet in length) may be placed per property for each scheduled collection.
 - (5) Brush mixed with foreign materials such as: stumps, roots, leaves, grass, lumber or any other material will not be collected.

(6) Brush pickup is limited to tree and shrub prunings only and excludes all land clearing debris and removal of trees which is the responsibility of contractors.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions hereof, are, to the extent of such inconsistencies, hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage, adoption, and publication in the manner prescribed by law.

TO AFFIRM THE BOROUGH OF CLEMENTON'S CIVIL RIGHTS POLICY WITH RESPECT TO ALL OFFICIALS, APPOINTEES, EMPLOYEES, PROSPECTIVE EMPLOYEES, VOLUNTEERS, INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS, AND MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC THAT COME INTO CONTACT WITH MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES, OFFICIALS AND VOLUNTEERS

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Borough of Clementon to treat the public, employees, prospective employees, appointees, volunteers and contractors in a manner consistent with all applicable civil rights laws and regulations including but not limited to the Federal Civil Rights Act of 1964 as subsequently amended, the New Jersey Law against Discrimination, the Americans with Disabilities Act and the Conscientious Employee Protection Act, and WHEREAS, the governing body of Clementon Borough has determined certain procedures need to be established to accomplish this policy; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council that:

Section 1. No official, employee, appointee or volunteer of the Borough by whatever title known, or any entity that is in any way a part of the Borough shall engage, either directly or indirectly in any act including the failure to act that constitutes discrimination, harassment or a violation of any person's constitutional rights while such official, employee, appointee, volunteer or entity is engaged in or acting on behalf of the Borough's business or using the facilities or property of the Borough.

Section 2. The prohibitions and requirements of this resolution shall extend to any person or entity, including but not limited to any volunteer organization or inter-local organization, whether structured as a governmental entity or a private entity, that receives authorization or support in any way from the Borough to provide services that otherwise could be performed by the Borough.

Section 3. Discrimination, harassment and civil rights shall be defined for purposes of this resolution using the latest definitions contained in the applicable Federal and State laws concerning discrimination, harassment and civil rights.

Section 4. The Municipal Administrator shall establish written procedures for any person to report alleged discrimination, harassment and violations of civil rights prohibited by this resolution. Such procedures shall include alternate ways to report a complaint so that the person making the complaint need not communicate with the alleged violator in the event the alleged violator would be the normal contact for such complaints.

Section 5. No person shall retaliate against any person who reports any alleged discrimination, harassment or violation of civil rights, provided however, that any person who reports alleged violations in bad faith shall be subject to appropriate discipline.

Section 6. The Municipal Administrator shall establish written procedures that require all officials, employees, appointees and volunteers of the Borough as well as all other entities subject to this resolution to periodically complete training concerning their duties, responsibilities and rights pursuant to this resolution.

Section 7. The Municipal Administrator shall establish a system to monitor compliance and shall report at least annually to the governing body the results of the monitoring.

Section 8. At least annually, the Municipal Administrator shall cause a summary of this resolution and the procedures established pursuant to this resolution to be communicated within the Borough. This communication shall include a

statement from the governing body expressing its unequivocal commitment to enforce this resolution. This summary shall also be posted on the Borough's website.

Section 9. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

Section 10. A copy of this resolution shall be published in the official newspaper of the Borough in order for the public to be made aware of this policy and the Borough's commitment to the implementation and enforcement of this policy.
