MINUTES OF THE BOROUGH OF CLEMENTON June 20th, 2023 7:00PM COUNCIL MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Councilwoman Franks reported that the Free Rabies Clinic had been successful and a record of over 100 animals had been vaccinated.

Councilman Dorsey stated that the Shredding Event had been attended by approximately 95 individuals.

It was noted that the Bike Rodeo had also been a successful community event.

NEW BUSINESS:

Councilman McKelvey announced that National Night Out was being held in August and further information was forthcoming. It was also noted that an Overdose Awareness Ceremony was being scheduled for September.

Brief discussion occurred regarding the intent to obtain emergency Narcan stations at the Community Center and Borough Hall Lobby. Chief Boyle was instructed to contact the County to ascertain if free units remained available, as they had recently been distributed to school districts.

Councilman Dorsey stated that he continued to be aware and concerned with speeding issues within the town, and inquired related to the installation of speed bumps/pads, potentially the portable type to be moved as required.

Jennifer Harris of ERI, the Municipal Engineer, stated that she would discuss the possibilities with her firm.

Mayor Weaver reminded the members of the governing body that Essie's was hosting an event on Saturday, June 24th, to mark the one-year anniversary of their opening.

PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR: Mayor Weaver opened the floor to the public for anyone interested in speaking. Seeing no members of the public wishing to speak, Mayor Weaver closed the floor for open comment.

EXECUTIVE SESSION:

Mayor Weaver stated that there was a need for executive discussion relating to anticipated or pending litigation.
